

# STARDISC

The StarDisc is a 21<sup>st</sup> century stone circle and celestial amphitheatre, located in Wirksworth's Stoney Wood. The disc is 12 metres (40ft) wide, with the central circle showing the northern hemisphere's night sky which is carved in black granite. It is inscribed with the constellations, their names and a depiction of the Milky Way.

Around the edge are 12 seats, which represent the 12 months of the year.

The StarDisc was created by Aidan Shingler and was unveiled on September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011. It is free to
