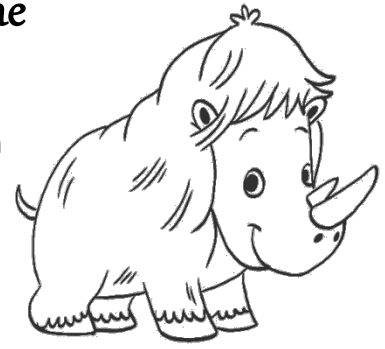


Woolly's Wander – Gallery One
