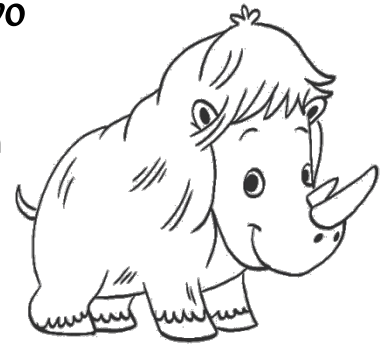


Woolly's Wander – Gallery Two
