Group Visits to Wirksworth Heritage Centre



We welcome visits from adult groups and offer a range of options for you to choose from, including a visit to our new museum, guided walk or talk on a particular topic.

We will always try to arrange activities to suit your time schedule, and if you have a particular focus or interest, **please ask - if we can, we will do it!** There's also a choice of different catering options at our in-house Webster's Café.

Group visits must involve a minimum of ten people and should be booked and confirmed at least one week in advance of the intended visit.







OPTIONS Visit to the Museum - £3.50 per person

Our new museum brings to life the stories of this fascinating town, illustrating Wirksworth's long history, the town's quirky qualities, famous characters, industries and its long-established rural customs and celebrations. You should allow one hour for a trip around the museum. A group of between 16 and 30 persons will be split in two, the overall time on site then being 1.5 hours. Larger groups can be accommodated in the same time by prior arrangement.

Our museum is fully accessible for all visitors by rear stairs from Webster's Café and all floors by a lift from the front of the building.

Women in Wirksworth

A talk exploring these connections and an up-close look at some of the literary objects in our collection.

The Story of Wirksworth

A brisk journey through the story of Wirksworth from its prehistoric origins, Roman visitors, wealth from lead mining and quarrying to its present status as a town full of creative professionals and a community that works together through sport, Arts Festival, even a Wizarding Day- keeping the town alive.

OPTIONS Guided Walks - £3.25 per person

Two walks are available. Both walks cover the story of Wirksworth with points of interest, and can be tailored to a group's own interests, or shortened to suit mobility needs and/or time constraints.

Flat Walk

A guided walk (approx. 45-60 minutes) around the more level parts of the town, taking in historic and architectural gems as well as tales of old Wirksworth.

Steep Walk

A guided walk (approx. 60 – 90 minutes) takes you round some of Wirksworth's scenic and historic highlights – amazing views over the town and landscape. This walk may not be suitable for all due to steep hills.

Our in-house Webster's Café provides your group with a range of catering options, and we can cater for people with specific dietary requirements. An outdoor cafe courtyard is also available.
